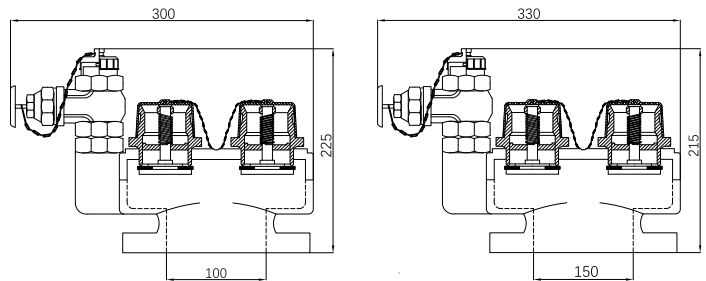


Breeching inlet

Breeching inlet (Inlet breeching) is normally located on the ground floor of building to enable the fire and rescue service to connect hoses to supply water into dry riser, so that water can be pumped up to higher floors.



- Certificate: BSI / LPCB Approved
- Standard: BS 5041-3
- Connection: Flanged to EN 1092-2
- Temperature: 0°C to 38°C
- Test pressure: 20 bar
- Surface: Red powder coating (RAL 3000)

Body	Spheroidal graphite iron (Ductile iron) as BS 2789	Inlet connection for hose	Copper alloy to BS 1400, with non-return valve
Drain valve	Copper alloy to BS 1400, design to BS 5154	Blank cap	Plastic or rubber, with chain
