

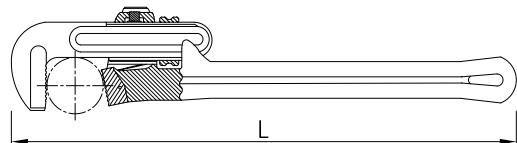
Pipe wrench

Pipe wrench from TPMC is a heavy-duty, adjustable hand tool designed to grip and turn pipes, fittings, and other cylindrical objects. It utilizes interlocking serrated jaws that provide a self-tightening action under load, delivering a powerful, secure grip and exceptional leverage.

It is ideal for tasks involving threaded metal pipes. Additionally, the housing incorporates a small, flat surface that can serve as a hammer for occasional light striking tasks.
